Summer Camp Counselors who fulfill their obligations at the Village and move on to college or paid employment elsewhere are provided with letters of support that help facilitate entry into their next adventure in life.

The Summer Camp Internship Program is an unpaid leadership experience, though opportunities for paid internships may arise as the program matures. However, Summer Camp Counselors should not enter into the program with the expectation of eventually obtaining a paid position.
