HOW WILL YOU DECORATE YOUR TABLE FOR THANKSGIVING THIS YEAR?

Using items you find around your home, build a centerpiece to place on your Thanksgiving table. All centerpieces should be themed around fall, gratefulness, Thanksgiving or your family's version of

- For children ages 9-11, centerpieces must be 90% child-made.
- For children ages 6-8, centerpieces must be 50% child-made.
- For children ages 5 and under, the child assists with age-appropriate tasks (choosing items, gluing, etc.)

CENTERPIECES WILL BE JUDGED IN THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:

- Outdoor Explorer: Centerpiece must be made primarily of natural elements such as squash, pinecones, flowers, etc.
- Reduce, Reuse, Recycle: Centerpiece must be made of recycled (cardboard, paper, plastic containers) and/or repurposed items found around the house.
- Toy Adventure: Centerpiece must feature one (or more) of your toys.
