#### COMMUNITY PARTNER INVITATION

Gilbert House Children's Museum designed Halloween Re-Engineered to provide children a safe experience that provided the joy of social unity during the height of the pandemic in 2020. This event was so well received that we have adopted it as one of our signature events.

In the spirit of A.C. Gilbert himself, we're inviting YOU to inspire wonder, spark imagination, and encourage creativity by using yours to build a working gizmo or gadget to deliver candy and treats to children from a distance.

### GIZMO TRICK-OR-TREAT GUIDELINES

Plan and build a gizmo, mechanism, or devise that will be used to deliver treats to children from a distance.

- Let us know what you plan to build. (Variety will spark imagination.)
- Gizmo ideas include: a zipline, a pulley system, a catapult, a slingshot, a pipeline, a launch system, etc. Imagination is your only limit.
  - Think simple, use recycled materials, scraps, and creativity.
    (Example: Materials for a ghost zipline could be fishing line, paper clips, lollipops, and tissues.)
- If possible, please provide the treat that works best with your gizmo! (Please consider common food allergens when making your selection.)
  - □ Plan for 500 children
  - □ Include promotional materials to highlight your business
- Provide a photo of your gadget and let us know what candy or treat you will be distributing by Monday, October 24, 2022.
- Plan to set-up your gizmo between 8am and 10am on Sunday, October 30, 2022.
- Plan to provide a team of two or more from your organization to operate your device at the event from 10:45am to 3:15pm on Sunday, October 30, 2022.
